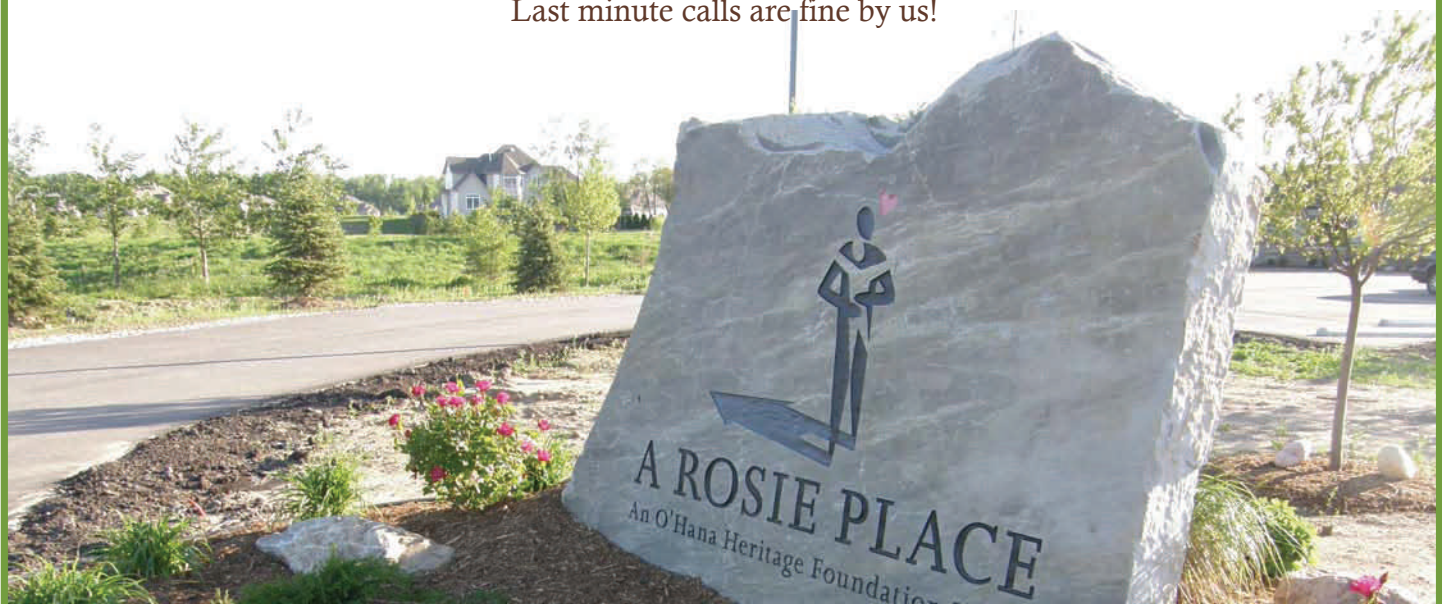

We will provide lunch along with on site childcare for medically fragile children and their siblings!

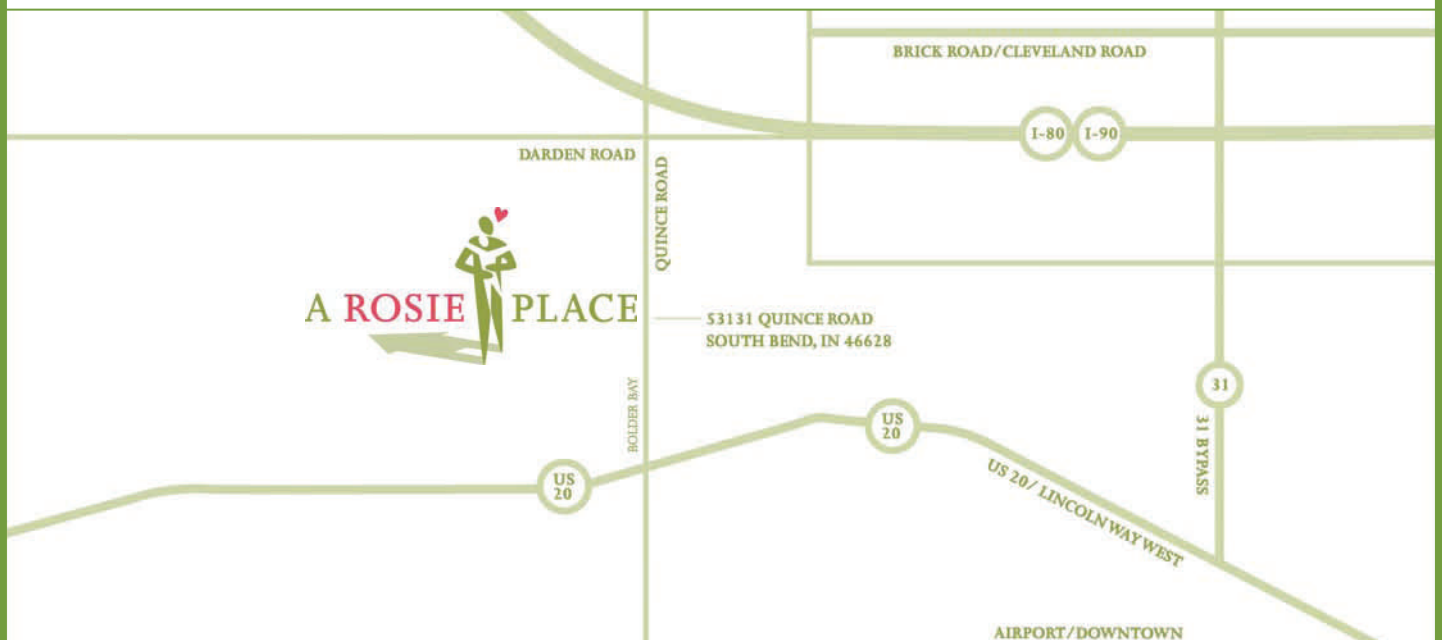
